**Articles of Association (45-64) allows for following category of membership:**

**Local Parish** 7 Governors appointed under article 50, 1 of whom is the Vicar (or his designate) & 6 appointed on the recommendation of the Local Parish Church Council  
Recommendation presented to Governing Board for consideration/ratification.

**LDBS** 1 Governor (appointed by the LDBS under article 51)  
The LDBS Governor Appointment Board interviews candidates when first appointed; for re-appointment, governors must demonstrate their contribution to the Board, number of meetings attended and training completed.

**Headteacher** 1 ex-officio governor (Article 52)

**Staff Governor** 1 elected by staff; total number of governors (including the Headteacher) employed by the Academy Trust to not exceed one third of the total number of governors  
Election process - nominations sought from staff body (teaching & non-teaching employed by the academy trust); if more than 1 nomination - an election takes place; 1 nomination - member of staff appointed.

**Parent Governors** 2 (elected under Articles 53-58)  
Nominations sought from the parent body; if more nominations received than the number of vacancies, candidates are requested to provide 150 words explaining their skills; parent body given the opportunity to vote as part of the election process; parent with most votes appointed as a parent governors

**Co-opted Governors** up to 3 (appointed under Article 59) by the Governing Board (not including other co-opted governors)  
Additional/ Further Governors appointed under Articles 60-64

All governors hold a four-year term of office
